Back in June we were very pleased, after much discussion with our good friends at Geocaching

HQ, that NZ Mega 2020 was officially awarded Mega Event status. This means that when the event page is published it will automatically be a Mega Event.

This comes as a result of the hard work put in by all of the previous Mega Event organisers in New Zealand, building a reputation that New Zealand can sustain ongoing events of this magnitude.

It means that the NZ Mega Team can focus all their energy into putting on a big event for the geocaching community, without needing to waste energy on simply trying to achieve mega status.

It also means that attendees can plan their geocaching adventures for 2020 a year or more out from the event, and in particular those coming from overseas have plenty of warning that there is a great event coming up that they won't want to miss!

While we still have some of the **NZ 2018 geocoins** available for sale, with all proceeds still going to the NZ Mega 2020 event, the big news is that our shipment of NZ Mega 2020 fundraising pathtags has arrived!

#### So what's with this whole 2020 thing anyway?

Well, the first answer is obvious – it's the year 2020. But as with most things, there's more to it than that. It's all about the 20's - 2020 is made up of two of them, and they stand for:

**20 years** of geocaching worldwide, the first geocache hidden near Portland, Oregon USA on May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2000 **20 years** since the first geocache hidden outside of the US, near Rotorua, New Zealand, on May 12<sup>th</sup> 2000

And we think all of that is worth having a pretty big celebration! So talk to your geo-friends and make your plans to be at NZ Mega 2020 as this is not going to be an event to miss!!!

#### Where and When?

The NZ Mega 2020 event will be held between 23<sup>rd</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of October, 2020, based mostly at the Pulman Park function centre located in the South Auckland suburb of Takanini. This chosen weekend is a 3 day weekend in New Zealand with a public holiday on the Monday.

There will be additional activities organised for the week before and after the mega weekend and these will be announced over the next 12 months, but the core mega event activities will take place over the weekend.

Pulman Park was chosen for a number of reasons including having a great internal space for the event, along with a number of break out rooms that will be utilised for workshops and seminars, it is surrounded by 64 hectares of park land, and there is ample convenient car parking located within the park.
